DoorLog OnLine provides customers with ID authenticated access for a variety of applications, including doors, key cabinets, electric gates, or any other application that requires real-time access control.

DoorLog OnLine is designed to actuate electric door strikes or a relay, depending on the specific application.

Customers can use EDT's WorldFleetLog to view DoorLog OnLine activity in real time, as well as to create reports according to user-defined time frames.

Management

- Set company specific parameters

Communications

- Integrated communications server receives, processes, and transmits data between DoorLog Online devices and WorldFleetLog databases
- Start Trip/End Trip events correspond to the DoorLog OnLine Activate/Deactivate events
- SMS backup
- ID by Dallas iButton, magnetic card reader, or variable range RF ID
- Programmable relay activation times
- Activate by commands from the office
- Supports remote activation by SMS
